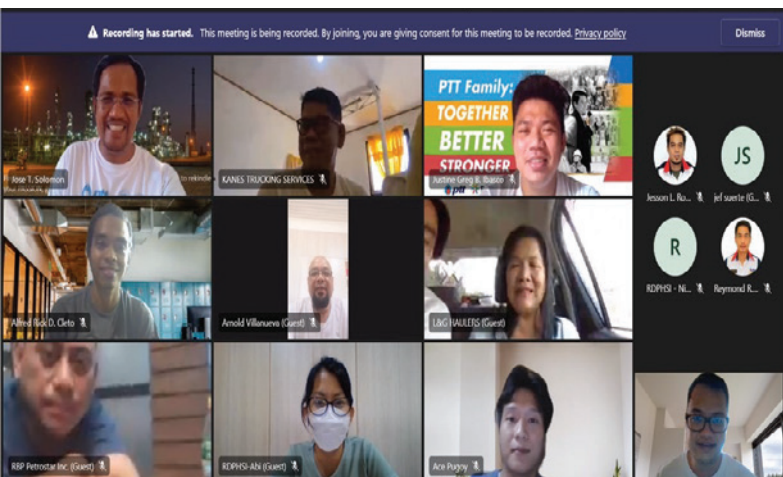

PTT Philippines refuels US aircrafts participating in Balikatan exercises



PTT Philippines has served as the official provider of JET A-1 fuel for US military aircrafts that participated in the recently concluded Balikatan 2022, an annual bilateral military exercise between the US military and the Armed Forces of the Philippines. PTT Philippines Trading Corporation President & Chief Executive Officer Danilo Alabado said PTT's into plane service of US military aircraft was made at the Subic International Airport where the military aircraft landed together with the civilian airline Omni Air International that transported US military troops. PTT refueller trucks were used for the refueling service in Subic. The Balikatan 22 started last March 28 and ended last April 8.

Haulers apprised on New Retain Sample, Fuel Marking Procedures



In the continuing Knowledge Management (KM) series of PTT Philippines, haulers this time were given an opportunity to further understand several procedures in petroleum products sampling. The QSHE Department, assisted by the Logistics Department, recently conducted the KM Session on New Retain Sample and Fuel Marking Procedures attended by representatives from various hauling services such as RD Policarpio, Kanes Trucking, L&G Hauling Services, RBP Petrostar, and Aim High. QSHE Team Head Jose Solomon said that the KM on the topic was in compliance with the Department of Energy's Circular No. DC 2003-11-010 Providing for the Rules and Regulations Governing the Business of Retail Liquid Petroleum Products and ASTM D4057-12 (Standard Practice for Manual Sampling of Petroleum and Petroleum Products). QSHE particularly discussed the new procedure in retaining product samples during every delivery, the standard procedure and protocol during the fuel marking inspection of Bureau of Customs in tank truck and PTT retail stations.

Training programs completed for retail stations



In support of various station opening within the 1st quarter of 2022, the Retail Academy Team has executed its comprehensive training modules for Service Station Safety, Forecourt Attendant, Cashiering, Product Knowledge and Authorized Receiver Accreditation Course. Retail Trainer Jorge Godoy led the on-site classroom trainings on a face-to-face format at PTT Stations in Abucay, Bataan; Novaliches, Quezon City; Naic, Cavite; Angono, Rizal; and San Nicolas, Tarlac. Combining classroom discussions and hands-on practice for a week-long period, it gave the station dealers and their personnel a better appreciation on the everyday duties, routine and importance of consistent execution of PTT standards of retail operations. PTT Medellin in Cebu, on the other hand, received a four (4)-day virtual training on the same modules. Teams from Retail Engineering and QSHE also gave their time and expertise during the commissioning of the station in preparation for its soft opening. The “Safely Serving the Customer & Keeping Oneself Safe” in this time of pandemic was given great emphasis by Academy Manager Jonathan Espino.
