PTT joins PAL's humanitarian flight to aid 'Odette' victims



PTT Philippines has joined several private institutions in sending donations to the victims of Typhoon Odette through the Humanitarian Flight initiated by aviation partner Philippines Airlines (PAL). PTT Philippines Support Group Director Paul Senador spearheaded the Thai oil firm in bringing bottled water donations to the airport for the humanitarian flight. Mr. Senador and other donor-companies such as Maynilad, Meralco, Makati Medical Center, and the Philippine Navy, among others, were received by Undersecretary Anthony Gerard "Jonji" Gonzales of the Office of the Presidential Assistant for Visayas. The group was also welcomed by Alvin Limqueco, PAL's SVP for Supply Chain Management. PAL's Airbus A320 was used in the humanitarian flight that brought a total of 40 tons of essential supplies, mostly composed of bottled water and generator sets.

Lending a helping hand to Cebu family



PTT Philippines family has launched its donation drive for some of its employees, particularly those based in Cebu province who were severely affected by the devastation left by typhoon Odette. A call for donation was immediately launched for PTT Family to help raise funds for PTT Cebu employees and contracted staff displaced by the typhoon. While they survived the impact of the typhoon, PTT Director for Support Group Paul Senador said, their homes and properties were destroyed by Typhoon Odette. "We are reaching out and appealing to our PTT Philippines Family to support this cash donation campaign primarily for PTT Cebu employees and contracted staff who were all severely affected," Senador appealed in an email message to PTT Family who immediately acted by sending their donations through GCash. A total of P68,650 fund was raised and sent to PTT Cebu employees who also received 60 cases of bottled water. PTT Philippines Corporation President & CEO Thitiroj Rergsumran, meanwhile, said that in times like this where disaster affects family members, the spirit of being one as a family is being tested. "As a family, we feel that we have the responsibility to lend a helping hand to whoever is in dire need of help especially during crisis or in times of disaster like this," Mr. Rergsumran said. Typhoon Odette, the 15th and the strongest storm to hit the Philippines in 2021, disrupted the lives of more than seven million people, according to a government data.
