PTT station cited in DOE-Angkas price monitoring project



The joint price monitoring project between the Department of Energy (DOE) and the motorcycle ride hailing operator Angkas earned one of PTT Philippines' service stations a seal of excellence after making it to the Top 10 Liquid Fuels Retail Outlets (LPRO) in Metro Manila.

DOE Assistant Director for Oil Industry Management Bureau (OIMB) Rodela Romero personally presented a plaque of appreciation and the seal of excellence to PTT Edsa Veterans in Quezon City in a simple awarding ceremony held recently at the station.

PTT Edsa Veterans was named among the Top 10 LPRO in the joint DOE-Angkas Near Real-Time Price Monitoring, a project aimed at providing consumers with accurate oil prices and information on quality services and facilities of gasoline stations in Metro Manila. "We are grateful that DOE and Angkas came out with this kind of project so that the public would have an informed choice about product and service excellence among oil players in the retail station level," PTT Philippines Corporation President & Chief Executive Officer Thitiroj Rergsumran said. "It is also an opportunity for us to improve on the kind of services that we provide our customers," he added.



The joint DOE-Angkas project, initially implemented from July 12 to November 15, 2021, facilitated the real-time monitoring of pump prices at individual stations via a mobile phone platform developed by the Energy department. The platform allowed Angkas riders to scan DOE quick response (QR) codes to report fuel prices to consumers, as posted in a specific retail outlet (RO). An assessment on the services and facilities of ROs had been included. PTT Philippines identified some of its ROs in Metro Manila to be covered by the project. The PTT Edsa Veterans earned an outstanding mark during the program run and was cited for its product and service excellence.

"This kind of undertaking by the government inspires us further to take on more challenges in keeping our commitment to provide fair prices and quality services to our customers," Mr. Rergsumran noted.

The DOE-Angkas collaboration project has its second phase beginning this May until November 2022. It now covers Metro Manila and Metro Cebu.

Retail Academy preps new Cavite, Laguna, Bulacan stations



In support of various station openings in the months of April and May, the Retail Academy has continued on implementing its comprehensive training modules designed for Service Station Safety, Forecourt Attendant, Cashiering, Product Knowledge and Authorized Receiver Accreditation Course. Retail Trainer Jorge Godoy led the latest training series particularly in Cavite, Laguna, and Bulacan areas. Participants from PTT Stations namely Governor Ferrer & Pag-Asa in Cavite, R. Magsaysay and Binan in Laguna, and San Jose Del Monte in Bulacan, were trained on a face-to-face approach inside their respective stations. The on-site learning activity was aimed at familiarizing the new station personnel on their new working environment. Each station had a week-long combined classroom discussions and hands-on practice. "This gave the station's dealer and their personnel a better appreciation on the everyday duties & responsibilities, and the importance of consistent execution of PTT standards of retail operations," says Academy Manager Jonathan Espino. "Safely Serving the Customer, Keeping Oneself Safe & Healthy is constantly emphasized in all our training programs."

QSHE, Red Cross hold Basic Life Support training in Olongapo, Cebu



In the continuing efforts of PTT Philippines to provide its employees with essential trainings and seminars on workplace safety, the QSHE Department in collaboration with the Philippine Red Cross recently conducted a series of "Basic Life Support and First Aid Training" for PTT employees from various work sites. Staff from PTT Makati, Edsa Vet, Clark, and Subic including those from Subic Loading Rack and Cubi Aviation joined the training held at the Philippine Red Cross-Olongapo Chapter last May 25-26, 2022. Participants from PTT Cebu, on the other hand, participated in the May 23, 24, 26 and 27, 2022 training conducted at the Philippine Red Cross-Cebu chapter Office. QSHE's Christian John Domingo said the training was aimed at producing new line of first-aiders and to serve as refresher course for existing first-aiders. Also, he said that it was part of PTT Philippines' compliance with Republic Act 11058, otherwise known as "An Act Strengthening Compliance with Occupational Safety and Health Standards and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof".

Majority of PTT employees get booster jabs

About 62 percent of PTT officers and staff have already received their booster shots even as the government announced that vaccines have been made more accessible through various vaccination sites. The HR and Admin Department reported that as of the latest, a total of 131 employees from a total of 212 combined workforce of PTT Philippines Corporation and PTT Philippines Trading Corporation, have already received their booster shots with majority (56) preferred Pfizer brand, followed by Moderna (45), AstraZeneca (26), and Sinovac (4). It is expected that the rest of the employees would follow suit especially after the Department of Health has reassured the public that with the vaccine, everyone is protected against the virus. Vaccines have been made more accessible through vaccination sites in pharmacies, schools, churches, and transportation centers apart from the the conduct of house-to-house vaccination.
